Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

You may be eligible for recognition of your prior learning and experience so you can fast-track your study.

Smart and Skilled - in some courses, your training may be partly subsidised by the NSW Government

VET FEE-HELP or FEE-HELP - eligible students in certain courses repay loans when income reaches a certain level.

Enrolling at Sydney TAFE

Most students follow these steps when enrolling for a course at Sydney TAFE:

- > Find a course
- > Check the course entry requirements
- > Get a Unique Student Identifier Number (USI)
- > Enrol online and pay or register your interest.

A different enrolment process will apply if you are an apprentice or trainee, an international student, a TAFE at School (TVET) student, or applying for a degree program.
